

## Sea Cross Marine exports navigation system for highspeed boats to NATO

Sea Cross Marine AB has received, through its customer Goldfish Boat AS, an order to deliver their high speed navigation system SeaCross of specially developed hardware and software to be used on the 36 RHIB developed by Goldfish Boats.

Goldfish Boat signed a contract earlier this year to deliver these 36 feet Rigid Hull Inflatable Boat RHIB to the Norwegian Navy.

Sea Cross Marine has developed a system for high-speed boats offering incomparable benefits for presenting information critical for high-speed boats. The SeaCross system combines sophisticated radar background underlay (RBU) and non-terrestrial object enhancement (NTE) to support military operations. The outstanding system reaction time (SRT) eliminates any delay in presentation of navigation information. The system is designed to present information without delay for speeds of up to 100 knots.

The SeaCross navigation system is very easy to use, something which is crucial for highspeed operations. The user interface is without "difficult to use" multifunction buttons and hidden menus. By using graphical icons, all functions can be accessed with only three buttons.
